Dear Urology Foundation,

Please find enclosed a cheque for £10,000 as a grant to you from Penguins Against Cancer (PAC), a charity set up to raise awareness of cancer and to provide support to cancer research and treatment organisations, and hospices. This follows the £3,000 grant we sent you in November 2020, the £3,000 grant we sent you in March 2020, the £2,000 grant we sent you in July 2017, the £1,000 grant we sent to you in December 2015, and the £2,000 grant we sent to you in January 2014.

This latest grant, to be used to directly support urological cancer research, has been made possible following the outstanding success of the recent Penguin Peloton 'Tower to Tower' [T3] bike ride from Guy's Hospital to Spinnaker Tower, Portsmouth which saw 16 Penguins, with a combined age in excess of 850 years, accompanied by 2 Black Cat support crew, complete nearly 100 miles of cycling. Thus far over £29 000 has been raised, including outstandingly generous support from Lord Kirkham's Foundation.

Our fundraising, sporting and social activities have been somewhat curtailed by COVID-19 but PAC remains vibrant, optimistic and forward-looking, not least due to the huge altruism demonstrated by our student members. We continue to wish you every success in your ongoing vital work to make significant advances in urological cancer research.
